


***Poetry for a Sustainable Future 2024 eTwinning* пројекат**

A world reborn, in shared respite.




Our home




The Earth

Trash does not belong in the yard, it should be in the garbage bins.


When I arrive at school I wanna see an environment that gives a good vibe.

I would like to smell the grass blooming on warm sunny days


Instead I lay awake at night wondering if more people will start caring and take responsibility


The world around me

A letter to Earth


My dear Earth,


In the shadow of the world, where thirst rages

Planet is big, save it!






